suggested answer (5 sentences):

George Orwell, whose real name was Eric Bair, was born in India in 1903 to a father who worked in the Bengal Civil Service. After he (had) finished his studies in Eton in 1921, he joined the Imperial Police in Burma, where he worked for five years. Then he returned to Europe where he worked in a number of menial jobs, about which he wrote a book called "Down and Out in Paris and London". In addition, he wrote a book about his experience of fighting on the republican side in the Spanish Civil War called "Homage to Catalonia", which was published in 1938, and also novels, the best known of which are "Animal Farm", published in 1945, which is a satire on communism, and "Nineteen Eighty-Four", published in 1949, which describes a nightmare future world. He died from tuberculosis in 1950, aged 47.
